She has published a diversity of articles and books in the music education field, including the PhD theses Musikkliteracy - En studie av instrumentalelever ved en norsk kulturskole og deres tilegnelse av musikkliteracy i lys av sosiokognitive teorier om barns læring (Blix, 2012), and Gender Issues in Scandinavian Music Education (Onsrud et. Al, 2021).
