4.4 Jazz/pop choir directing (Aarhus)

The audition is held at RAMA in Aarhus or via video recording and Zoom (this is optional for both Danish and international students)

PART 1: Jazz/pop choir directing (30 minutes)

The applicant uses their own vocal ensemble at intermediate/advanced level, consisting of minimum 12 singers and at least four voices.

- **Concert directing** of a work known to the vocal ensemble. One sing-through.
- Rehearsal of an assigned task with the ensemble (the applicant has one week of preparation time).

A description of the ensemble and the chosen concert piece must be submitted to the study office no later than two weeks before the audition. A copy of the material (sheet music, text, etc.) to be used during the audition must be attached as an attachment in PDF format.

PART 2: Interview, singing and piano (30 minutes)

- A self-chosen song with own accompaniment on piano.
- A self-chosen piano piece (no singing).
- Secunda vista: Figuration accompaniment, sight reading and singing. The assignment is handed out 30 minutes before the audition.
- Interview with questions related to part 1.

Total duration: 60 minutes.

One grade is provided for the jazz/pop choir directing and one overall grade is provided for the self-chosen song and piano piece and one grade is provided for the secunda vista.
