Your admission test for the Pop/Jazz Music programme will be conducted digitally. One part of your admission will consist of an uploaded video and the rest will be conducted online via Zoom.

Test in main instrument: **Concert - BACHELOR**

- The applicant must play self-chosen tunes on their main instrument with their own band
- At least 2 accompanists must participate in the concert.
- The concert must be no longer than 10 minutes.
- Improvisation from the applicant must be included under consideration for the musical entirety and style related characteristics.

Test in main instrument: **Concert - MASTER**

- The applicant must play self-chosen tunes on their main instrument with their own band
- At least 2 accompanists must participate in the concert.
- Improvisation must be a part of the test.
- The applicant must perform the concert without scores and the concert may not last longer than 10 minutes.

The uploaded video must be an unedited video recording of your performance test. It is very important that no login or subscription is required for the examiners to watch your video, so you can e.g. use a private YouTube channel, which is accessible via a direct link only.
